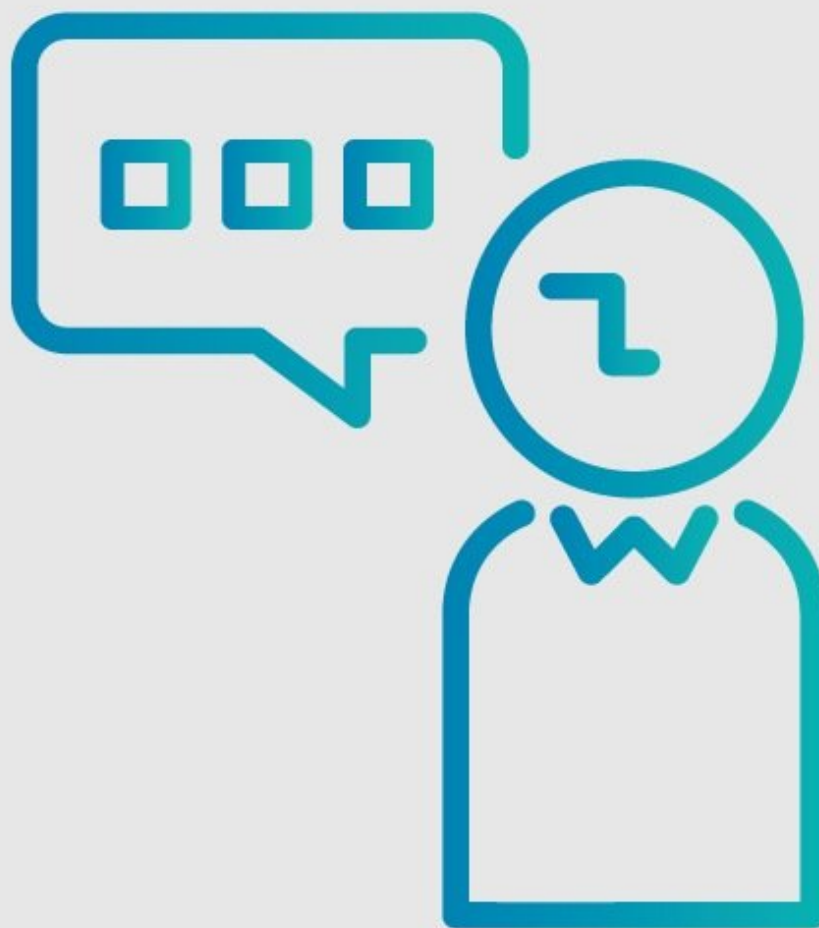

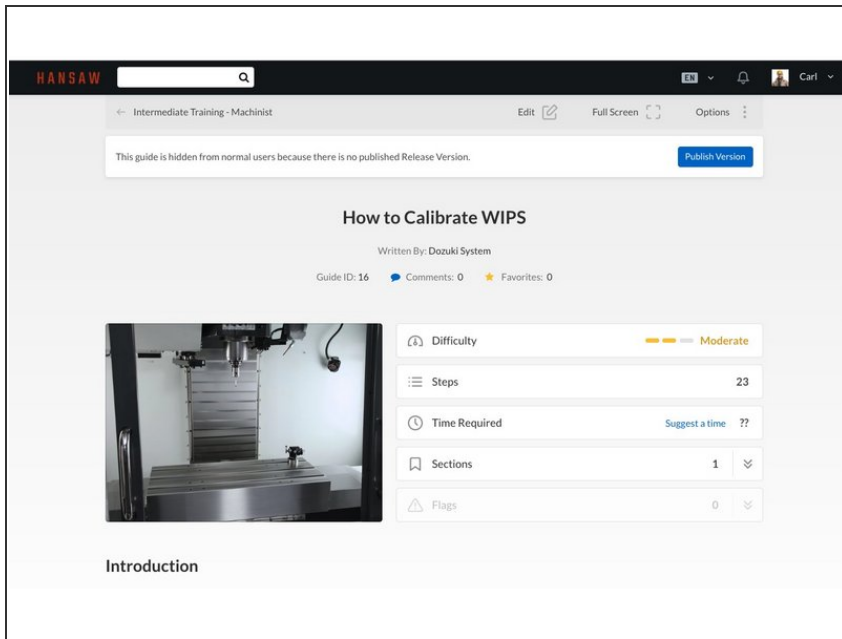


## **INTRODUCTION**

This guide demonstrates how to machine translate a guide.

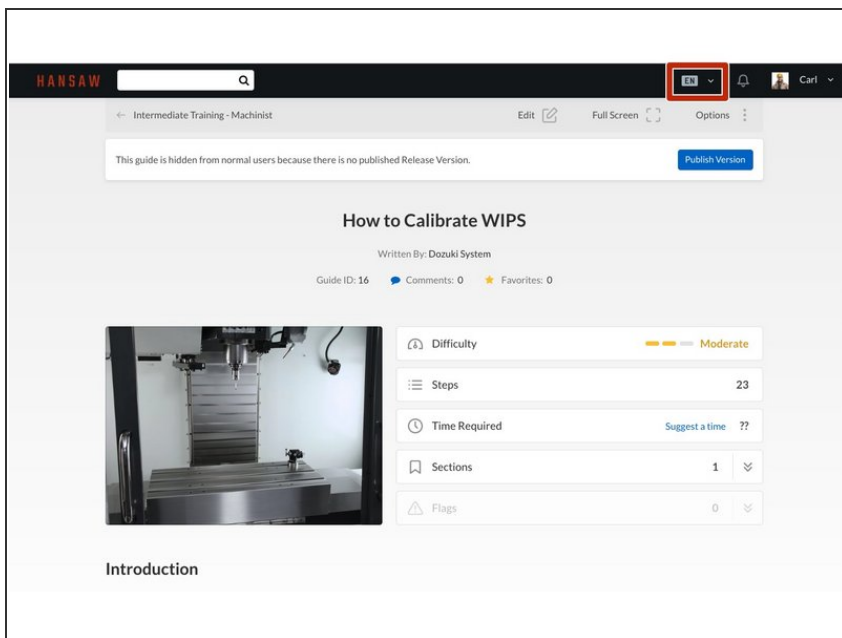
It is recommended to manually translate guides into needed languages. However, if you need to view a guide in a language different from what it was originally written in, or has been manually translated into, this guide teaches you how to machine translate the guide.

## Step 1 — How to Machine Translate a Guide



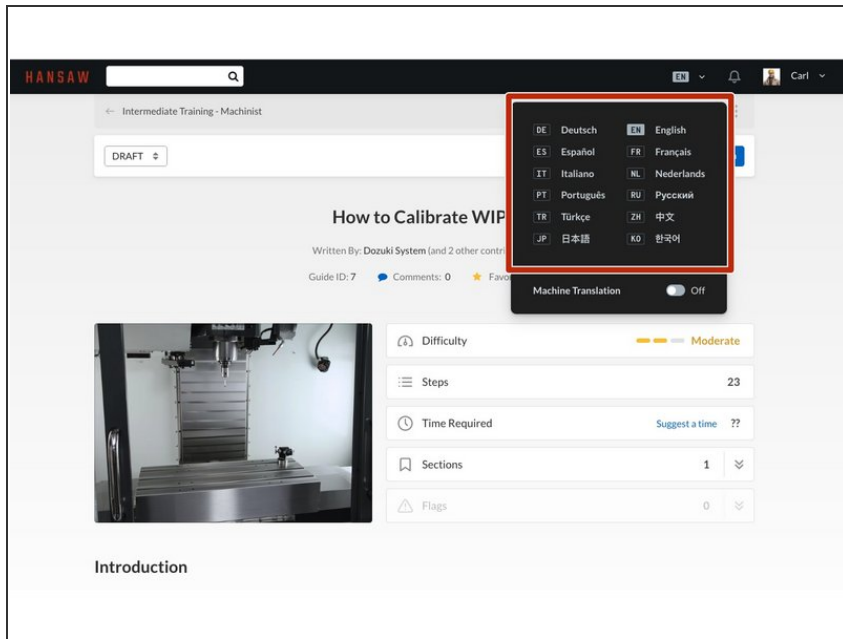
- Navigate to the guide you want to machine translate.

## Step 2



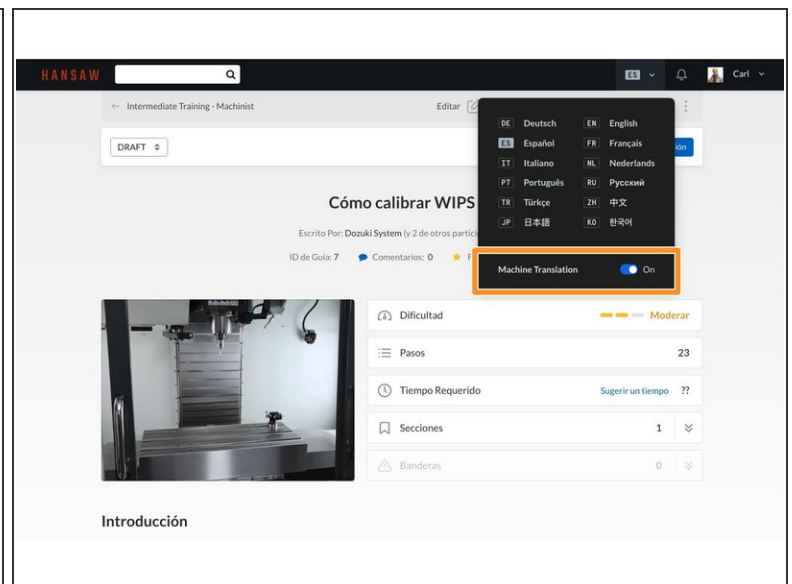
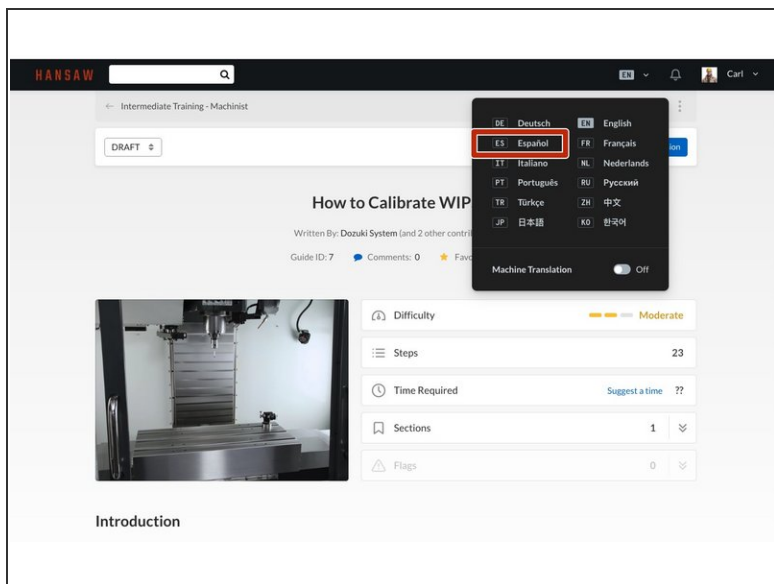
- Locate the **Language** drop-down menu on the right side of the site header.


## Step 3



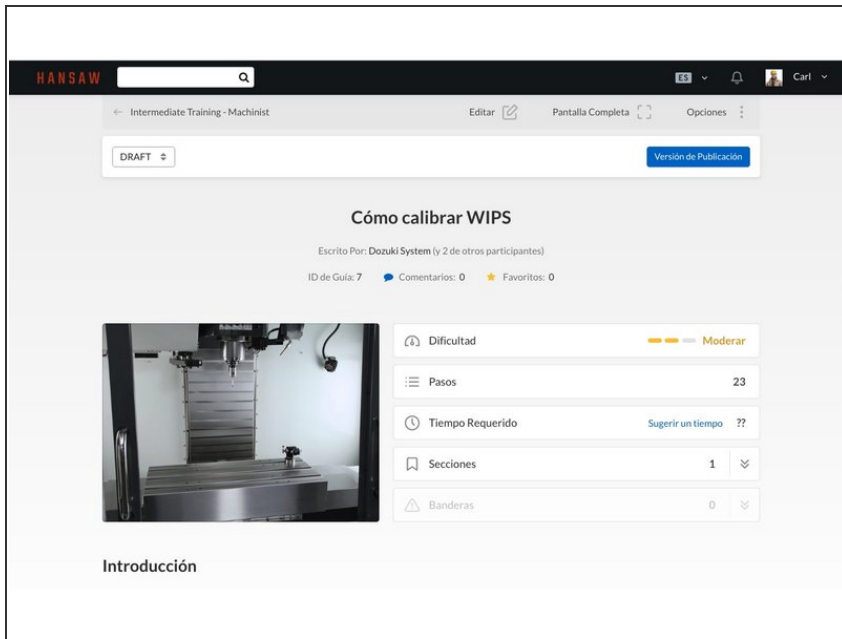
- Click to expand the drop-down menu to reveal a list of languages to which your guide can be translated.


## Step 4



- Select your desired language by clicking on it.
-  For the purpose of this example, the site will be translated into Spanish.
- At bottom of the language list, toggle the Machine Translation **ON**.

## Step 5



- The guide will refresh, and is now in the desired language.
-  You have changed the site language so the entire site interface will now be in the selected language.
