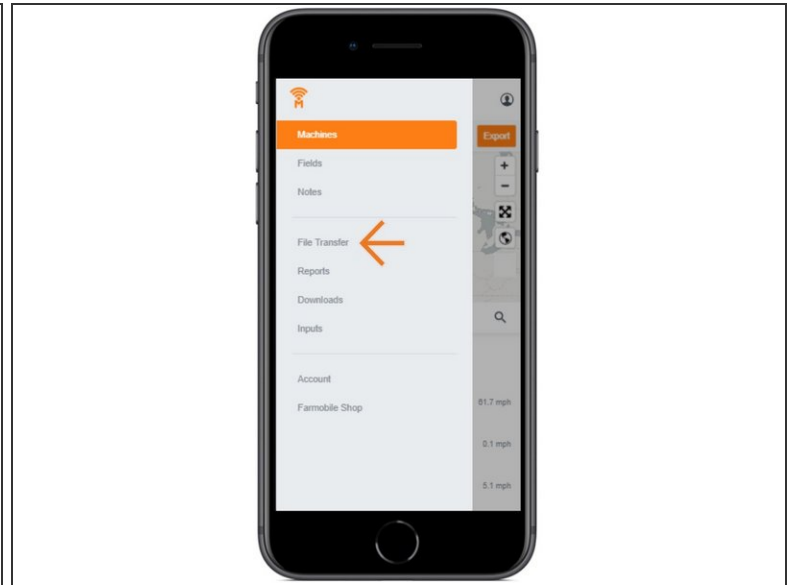
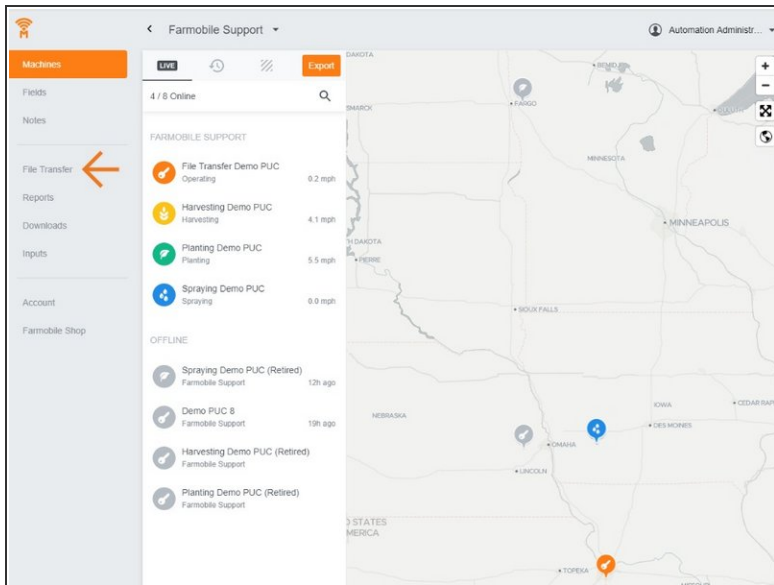

INTRODUCTION

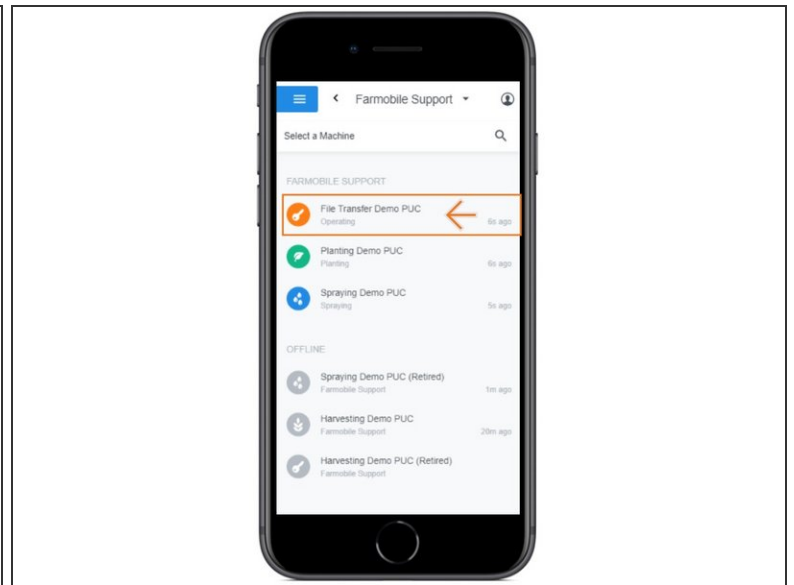
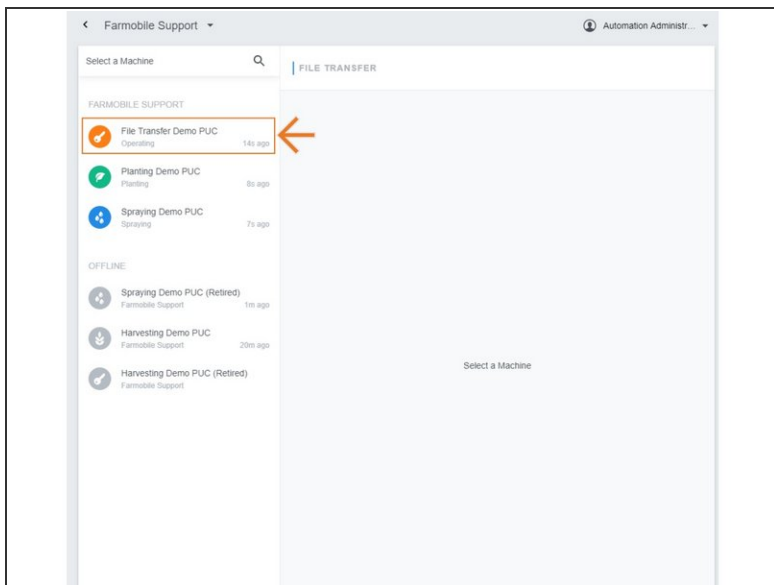
- User has the ability download files or folders from the PUC to a local device.

- When downloading a folder, all contents within the folder are downloaded and zipped into a compressed folder.

Step 1 — Select File Transfer from the Farmobile® DataEngine™ Menu



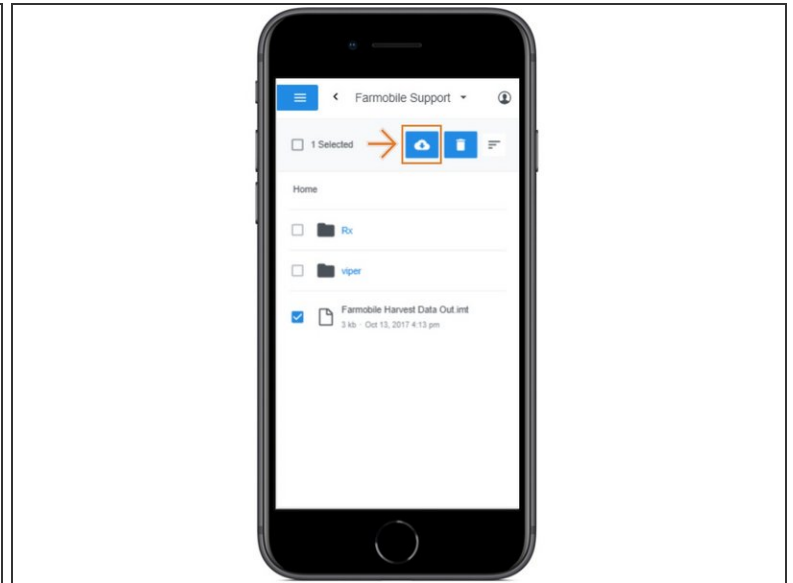
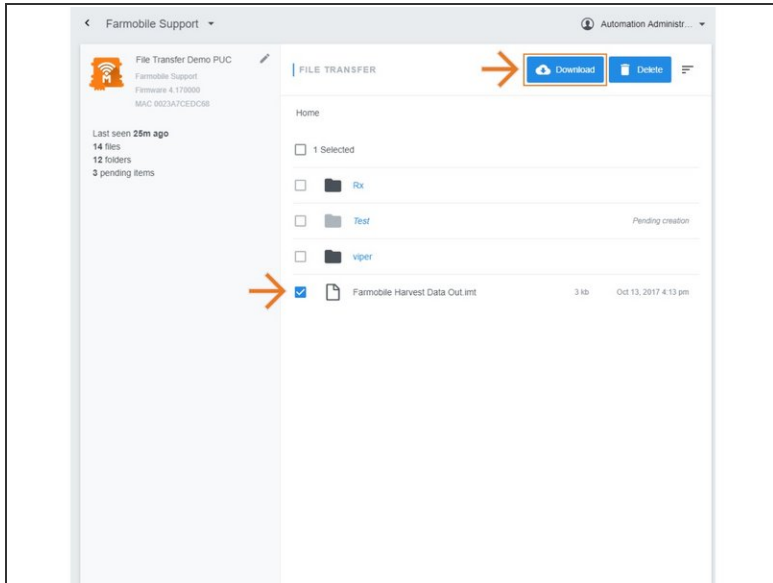
- Selecting File Transfer from the Farmobile® DataEngine™ menu will open the File Transfer page with all of you PUCs listed.

Step 2 — Select a PUC



- From the list of PUCs, select the required PUC to Upload a file or folder to.

Step 3 — Select a File or Folder and Download



- You can select all or just one.
- By checking the box of a File or Folder, the Upload button will turn into the Download button.
- Select the Download button to kick off the download process.
- Selecting a Folder will download all the files within.
- Your file or folder is downloaded directly to your browser so you can save and share!
