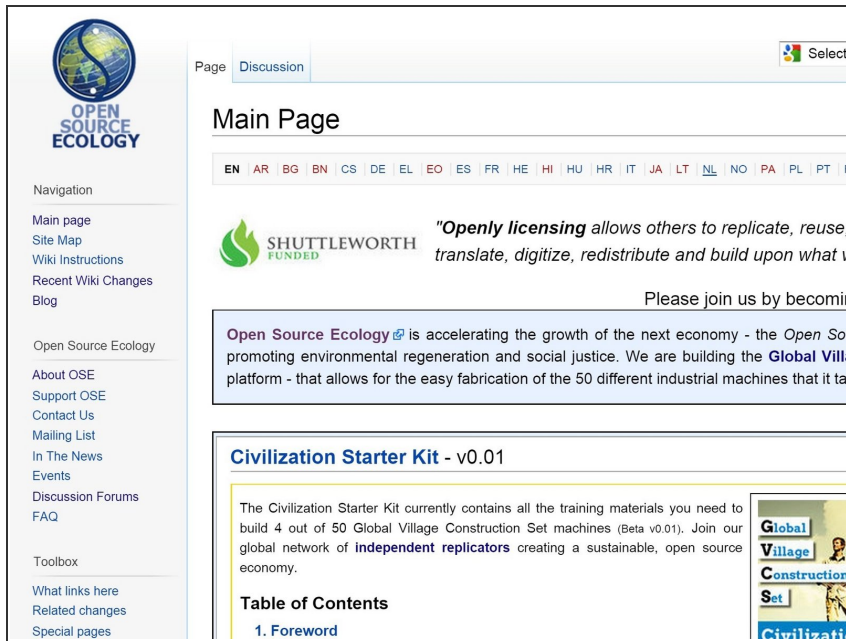

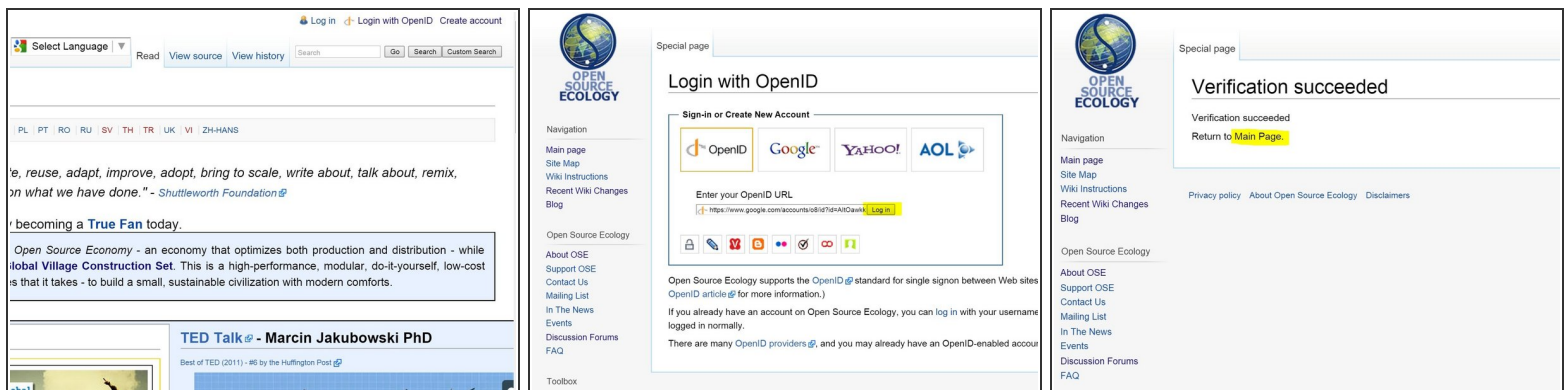


Step 1 — Creating a Work Log



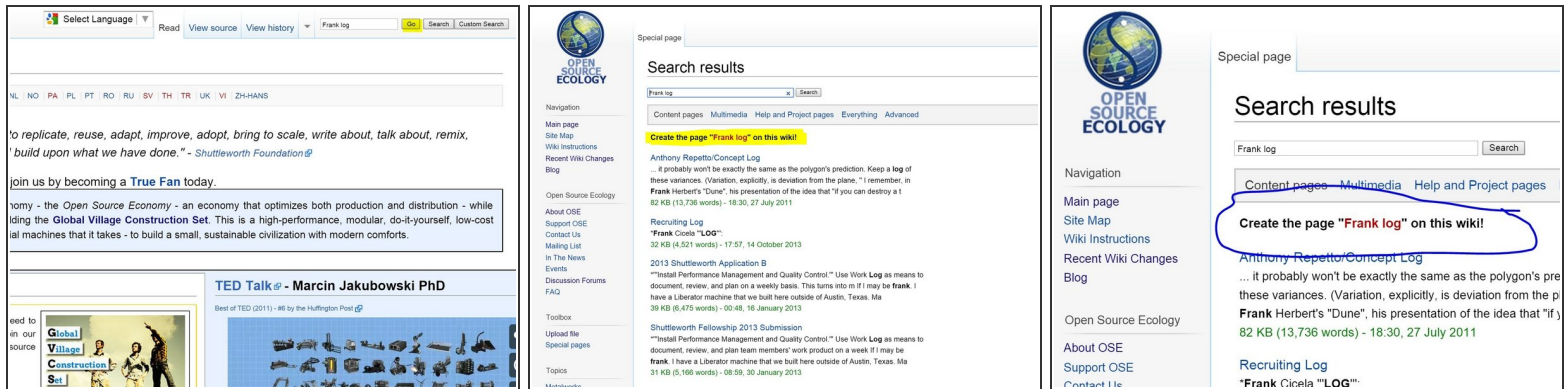
- Learning to how to use a wiki can seem difficult, but with a short guide you can create a work log.

Step 2 — Logging in with OpenID



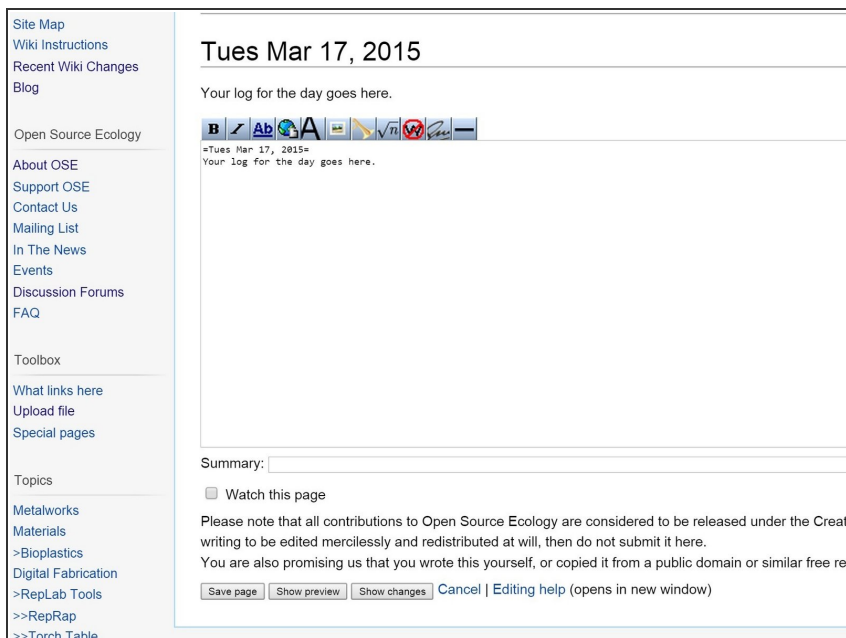
- In the top right hand corner click Login with OpenID
- Click Login.
- Once the Verification succeeds. Click Main Page link.

Step 3 — Creating a Work Log



- Go to search bar.
- Type in your first name and then the word log. For example, Frank log, and press go.
- If there is a duplicate log name, then please use your first name and last name initial and then log. For example, Frank G Log.
- If there is not a duplicate name, **look very carefully** for the Create the page "Frank log" on this wiki. Of course "Your First Name Log".

Step 4 — Adding date and first work log entry.



- Copy this: =Tues, Mar 17, 2015=
- Change the date to current date. Write this is my first work entry. Hello World!
- Save page.
- Done.
